# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

AS OF 25<sup>TH</sup> APRIL



## Case Load analysis

1. MH has seen 7,628 cases, 1,076 recoveries & 323 deaths to date; Also 811 new cases & 22 new deaths reported in the last 24 hours
2. MH **Doubling Rate** remains unchanged vis-à-vis previous week at **6.6 days**; but **lower vs 3 day prior Doubling Rate of 7.3**
3. Similarly, week-on-week **improvements** seen in **Case Fatality Rate (2.8% this week v/s 4.5% last week & 3.0% three days back)**
4. **10 districts** reported no new cases in the last 7 days; districts to be carefully monitored & moved to **Orange zone** by 3<sup>rd</sup> May.
5. **3 districts** have reported no cases till date & 4 districts have reported no cases in last 21 days ; critical to monitor & maintain **Green zone status**
6. Only 4 districts i.e. Dhule (1.5), Nandurbar (2.0), Hingoli (2.3) & Jalgaon (2.6) have doubling rates  $\leq 4$  days (weekly case growth  $>20\%$ ); strong focus to ramp up containment measures in these districts

## Treatment

1. Mumbai has  $>80\%$  utilization in isolation beds
2. Akola & Nashik have utilization  $>80\%$  in institutional quarantine beds.

## Testing

1. Total tests per million: Maharashtra (876) ranks lower than Delhi (1,668), Rajasthan (952) & Tamil Nadu (952) but top 2 hot spot districts - **Mumbai (3,890) and Thane (2,308) have highest testing rate (per million) in India**
2. There has been a  **$\sim 28\%$  week-on-week growth** in the number of **tests** conducted this **week (40,511)** with increase in overall hit rate to **8.6%** this week from **5.5%** last week
3. Private labs account for 52% of overall testing volume with the balance from Government labs
4. **Substantial improvement** in **Hit rate** of **Private labs** to **9.5%** this week from **4.9%** last week & v/s **8.9%** in government labs

## Contact Tracing & Containment

1.  **$\sim 125,000$  people home quarantined** (**+52%** over last week) and  **$\sim 8,000$  people in institutional quarantine** (**+16%** over last week)
2. Dhule, Thane, Jalna, Hingoli & Mumbai have  **$<55\%$  contacts traced**; need to expedite contact tracing process

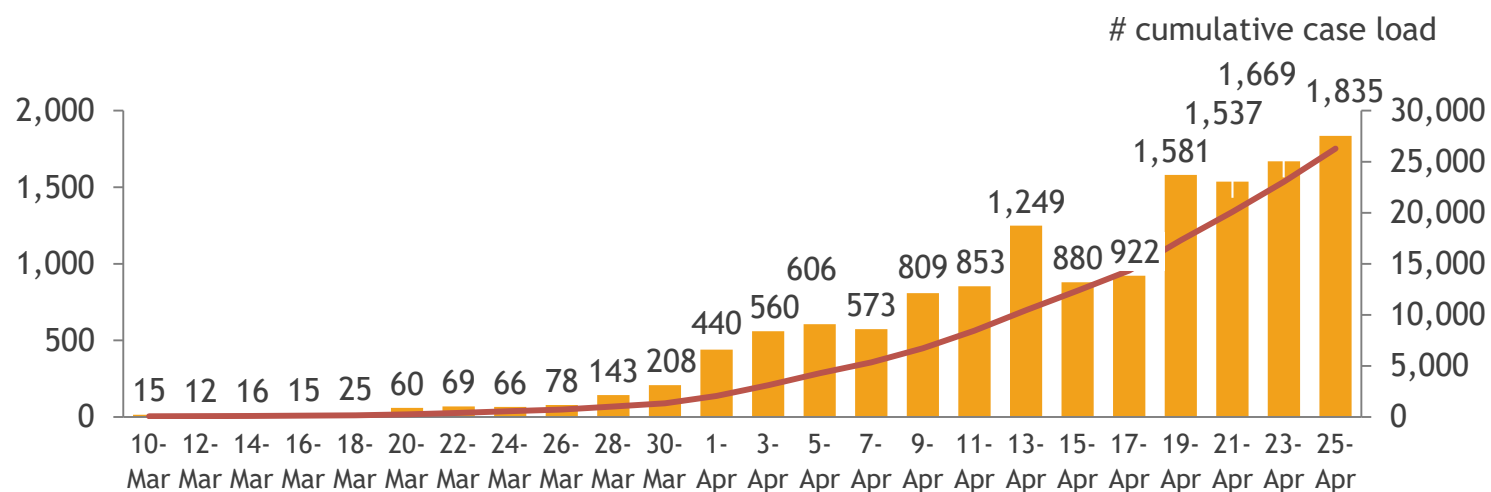

## India Case load trend



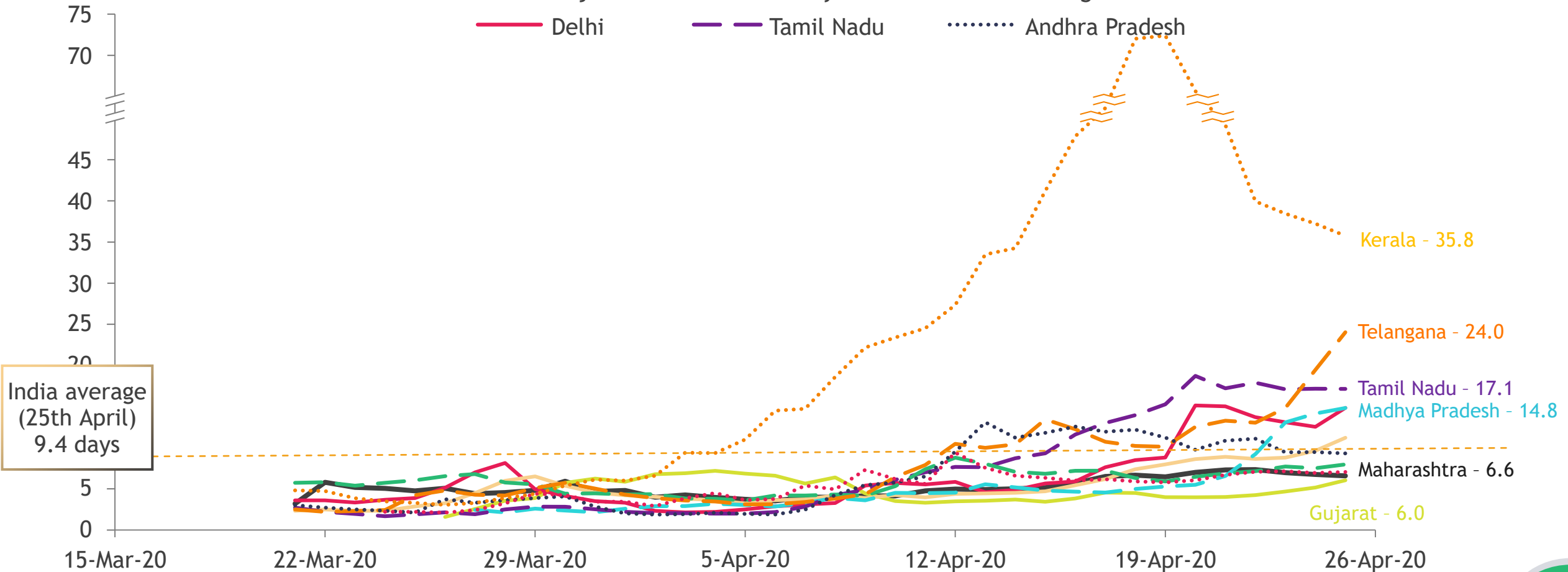

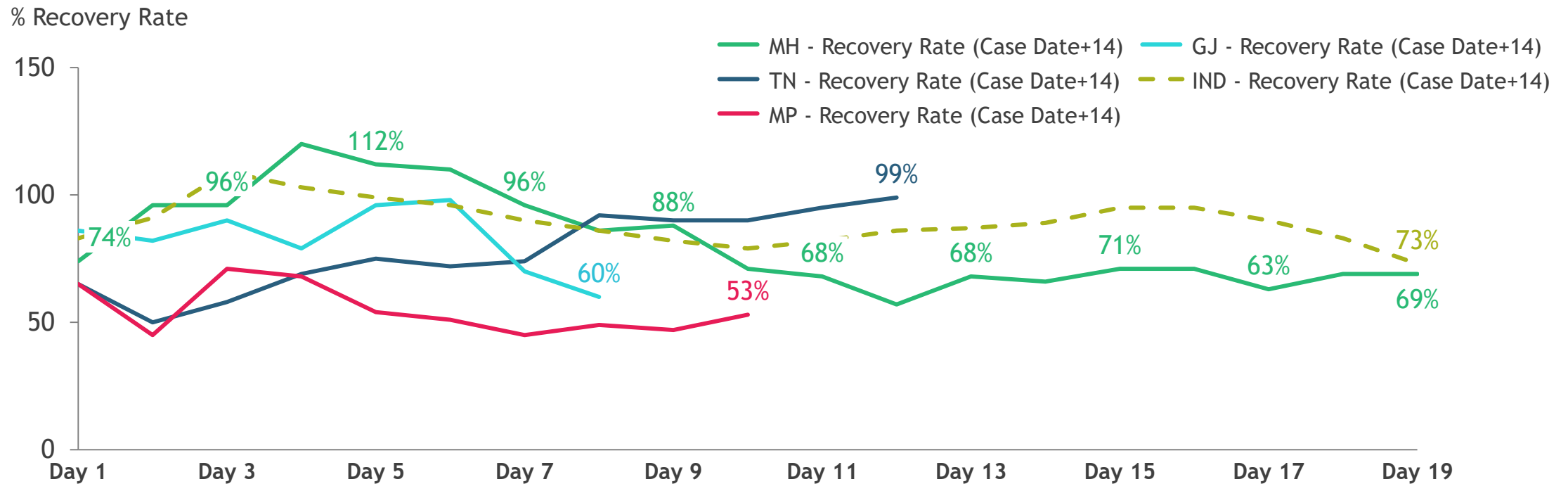

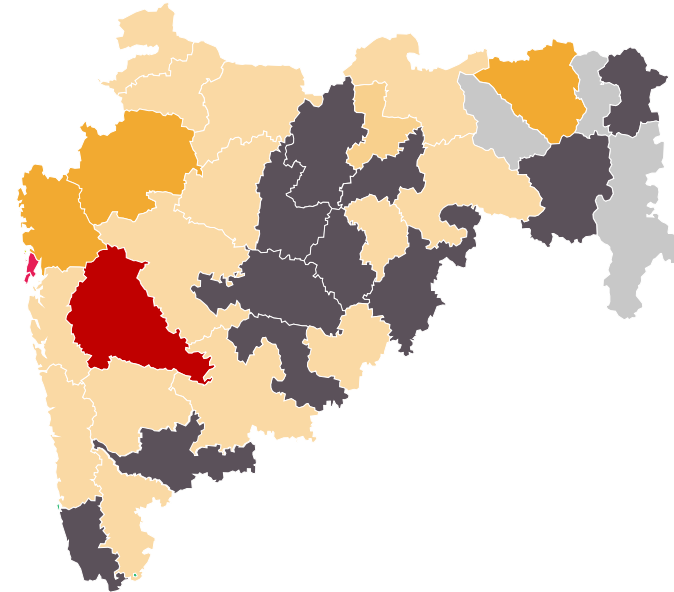

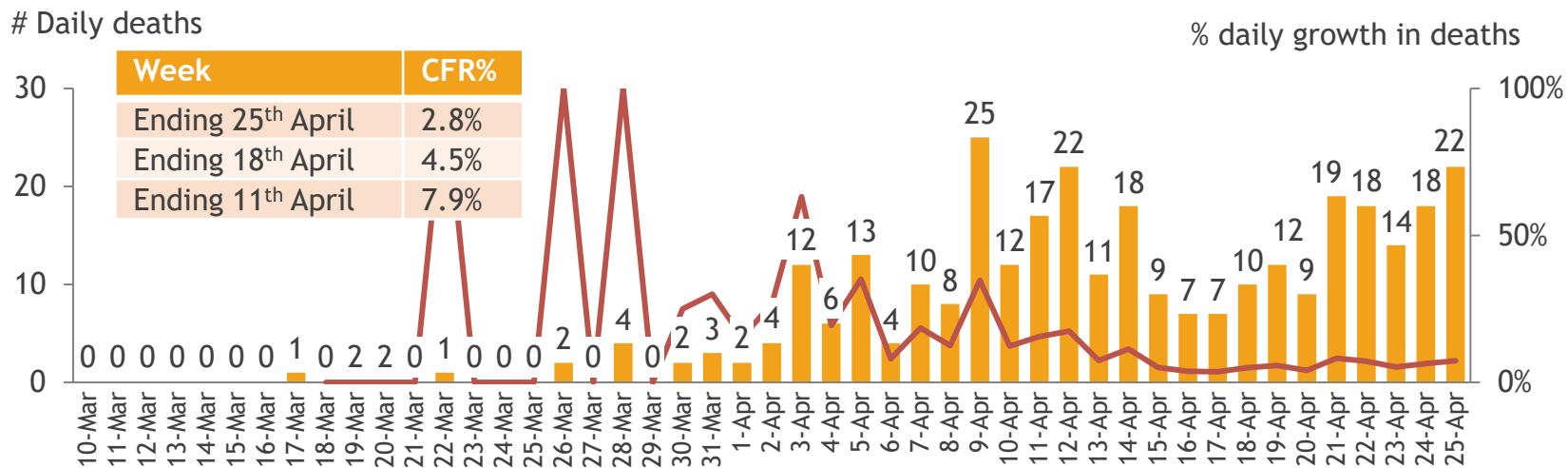


### MH Case Load Trend

## Best practice adopted in Sangli to contain spread of COVID

1. Quick formation and deployment of District Rapid Response Teams to trace all contacts of affected patients
2. Precision approach adopted to stop the further spread via contacts:
  - Symptomatic high risk contacts: Isolate and test
  - Asymptomatic contacts: Institutional quarantine
  - All low risk contacts: Home quarantined
3. All entry & exit points were sealed in containment zones (1 Km radius) and buffer zones
4. Strict enforcement of social distancing

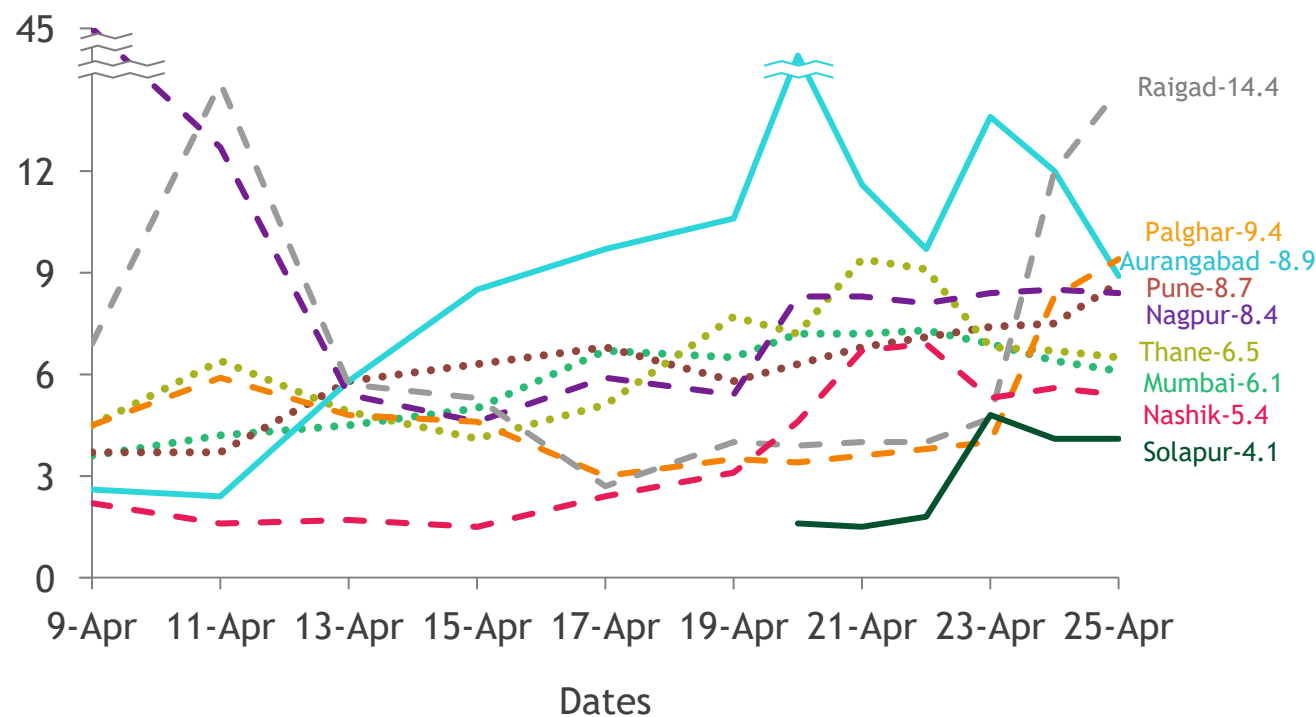

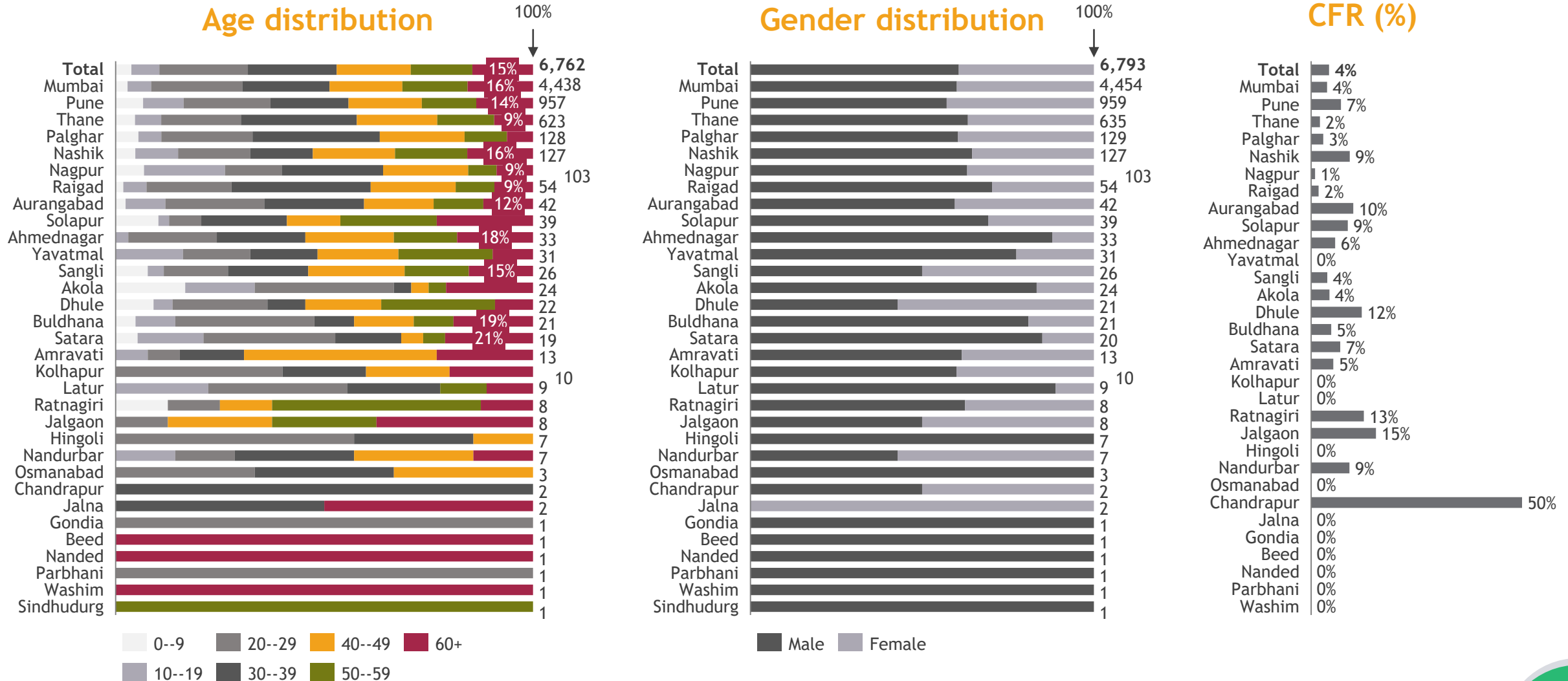

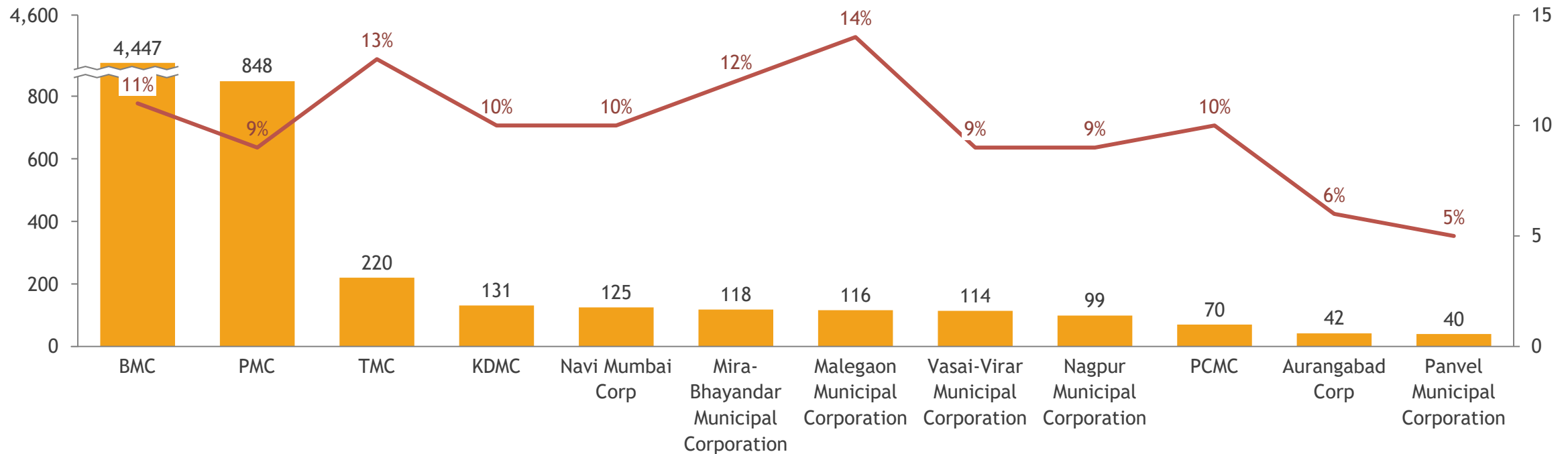

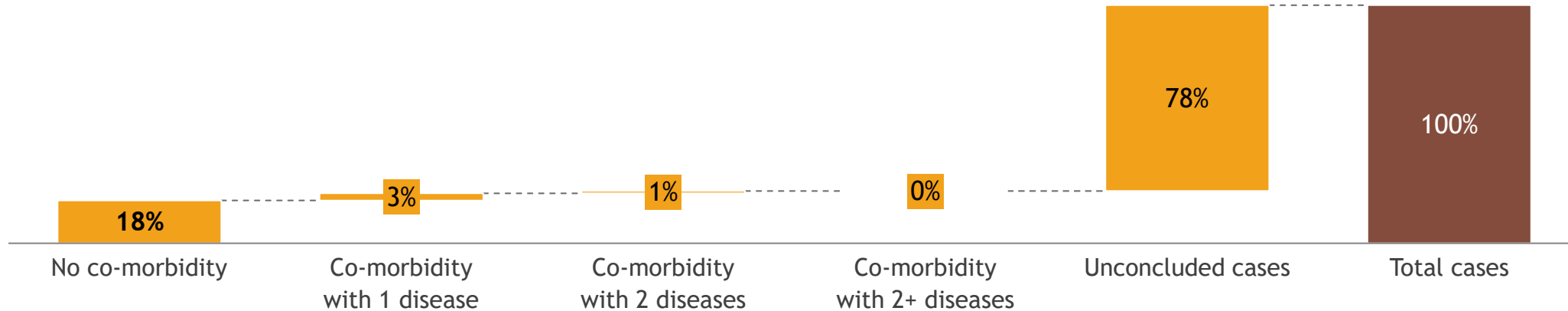

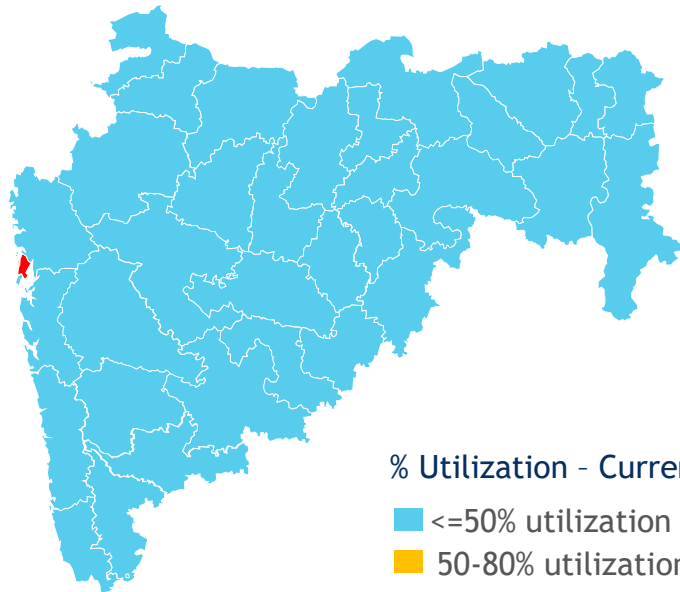

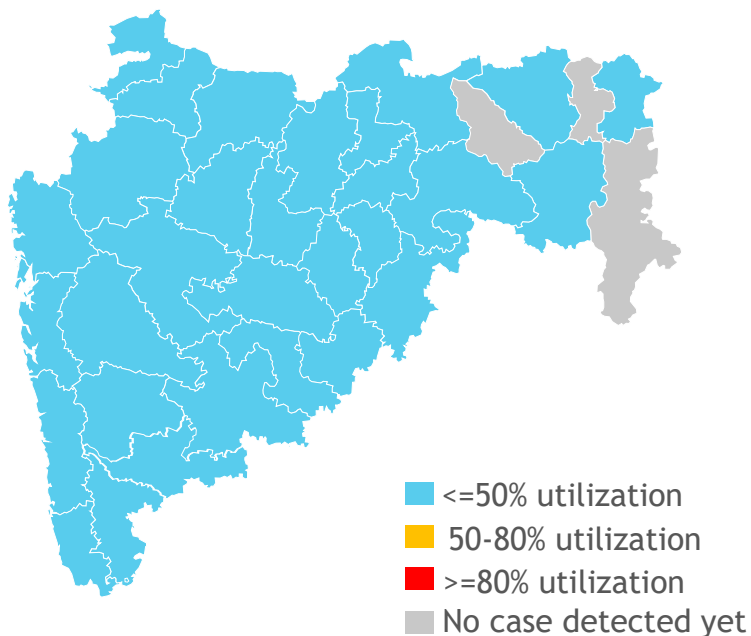

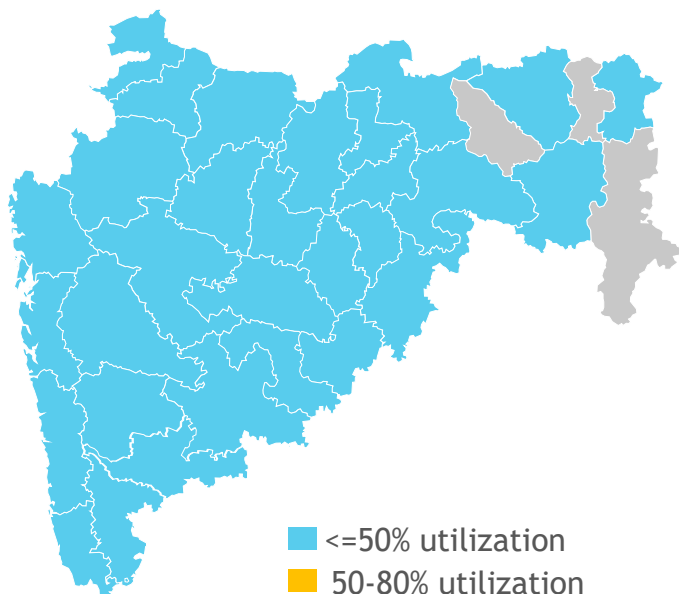

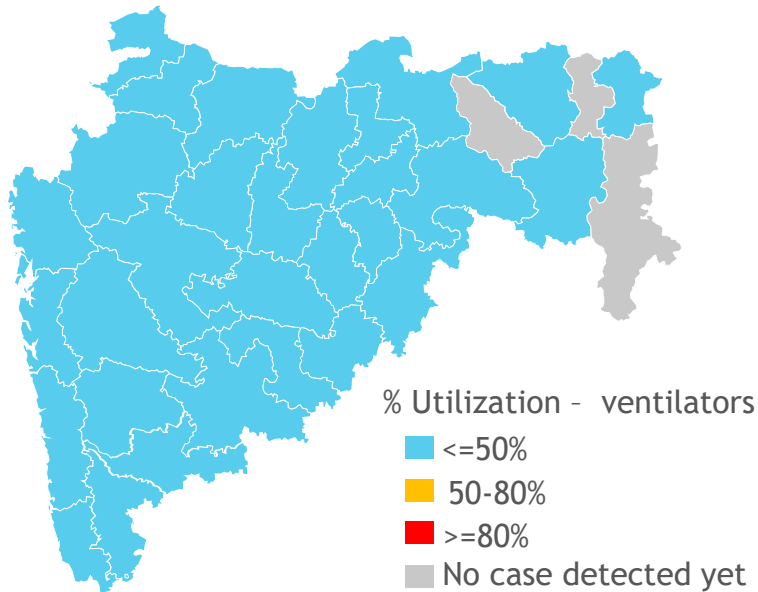

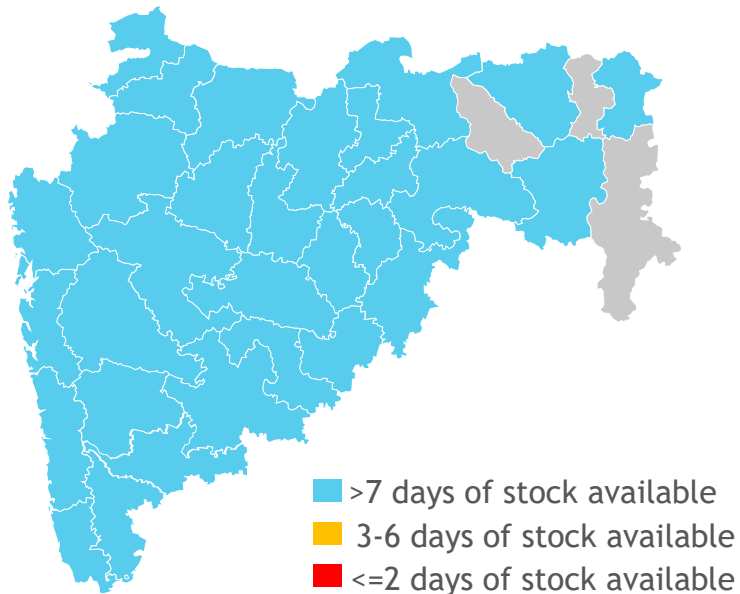

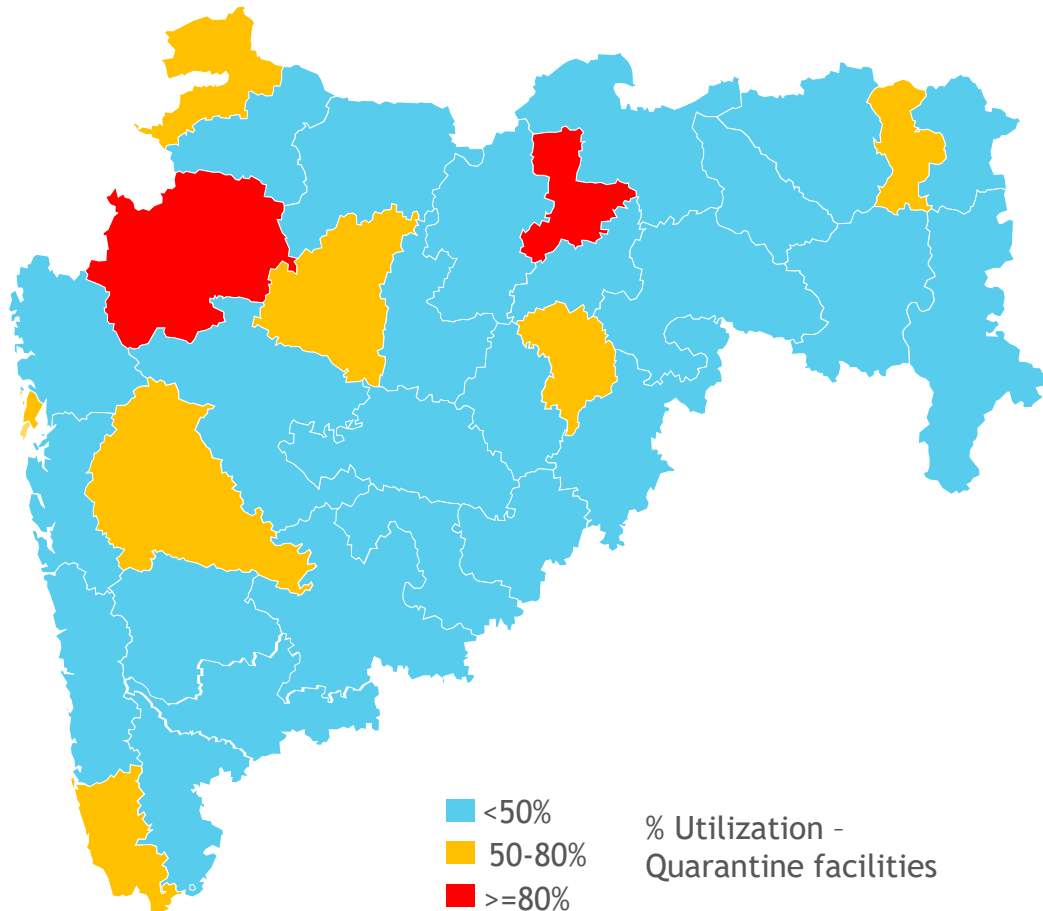

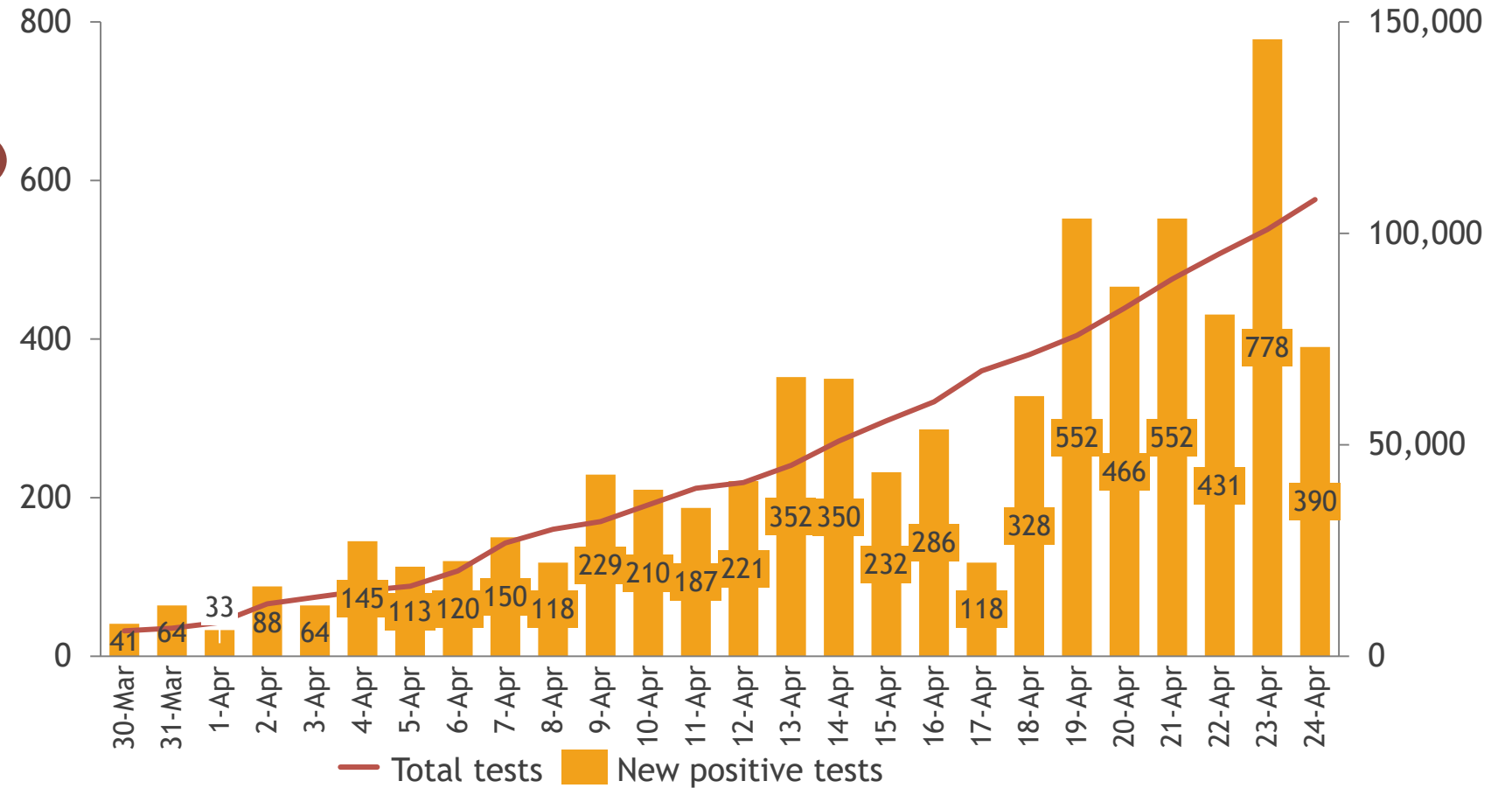

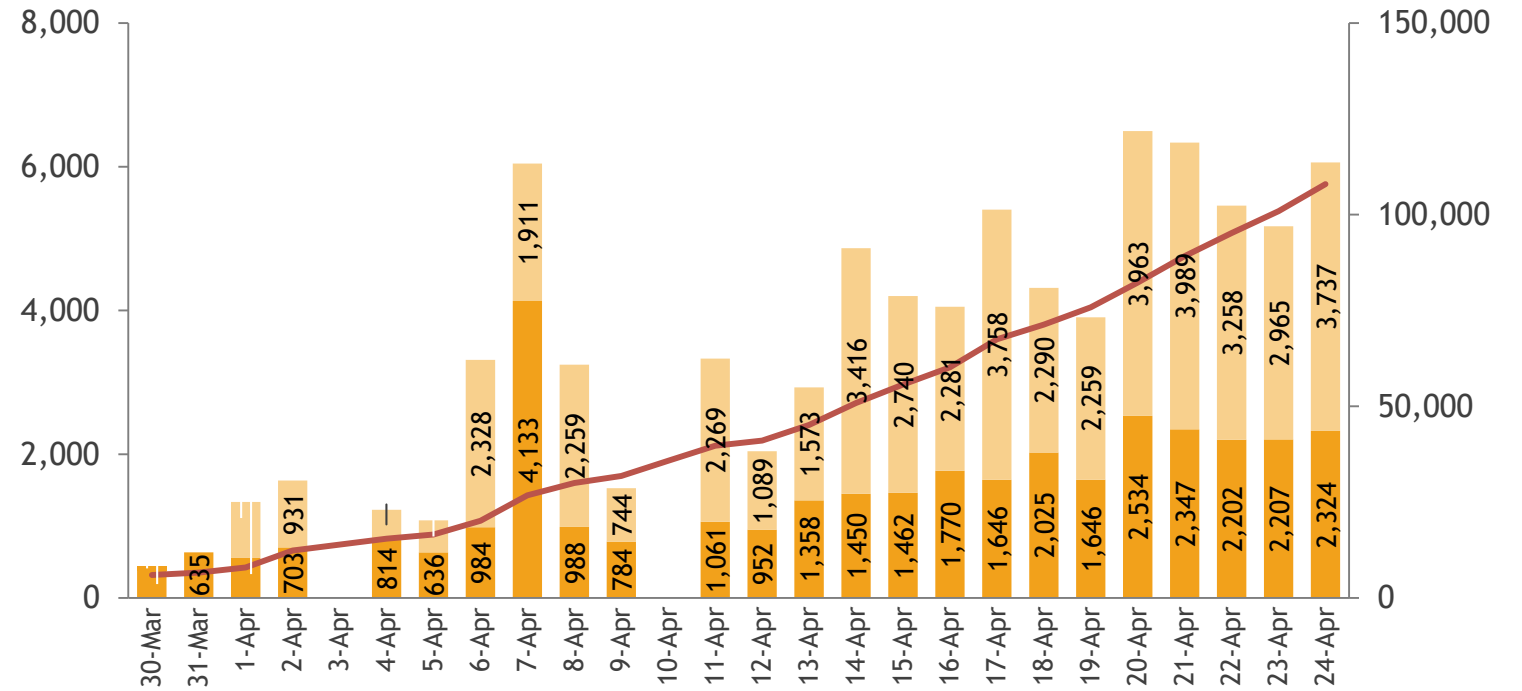

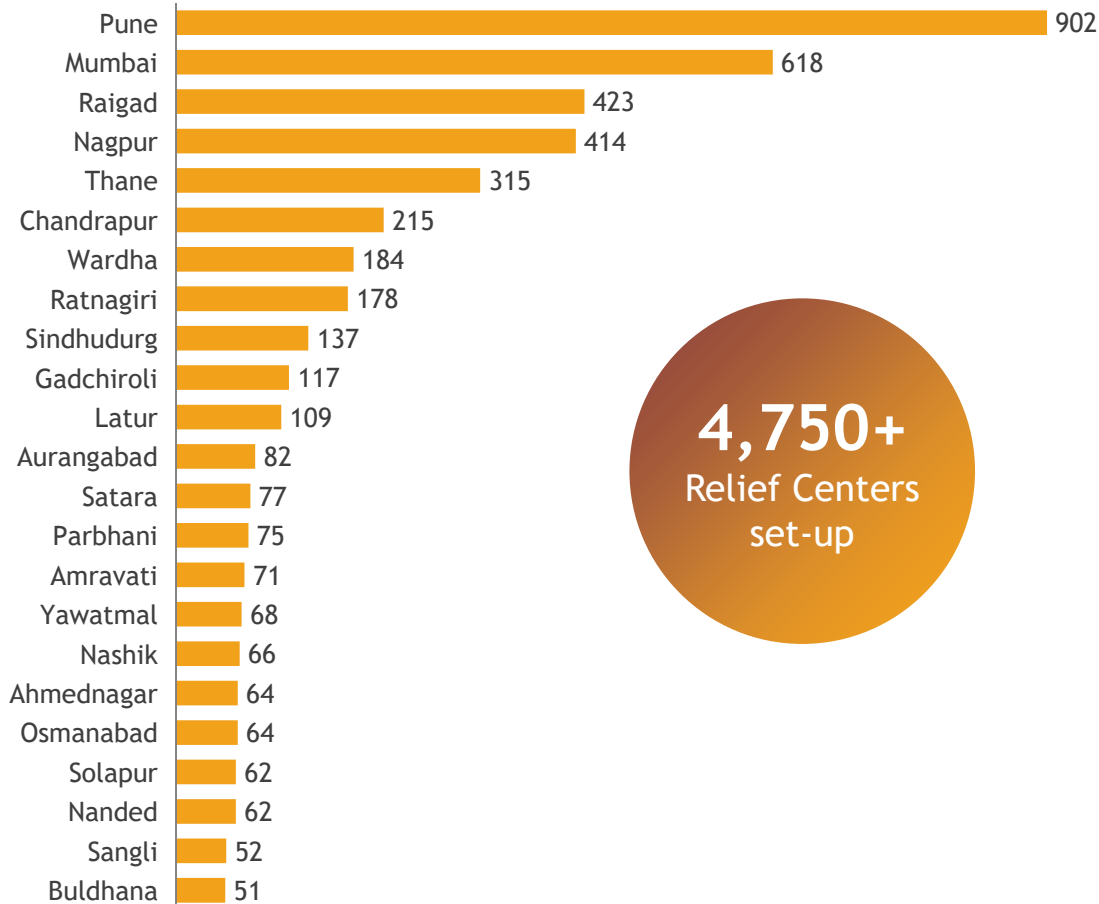

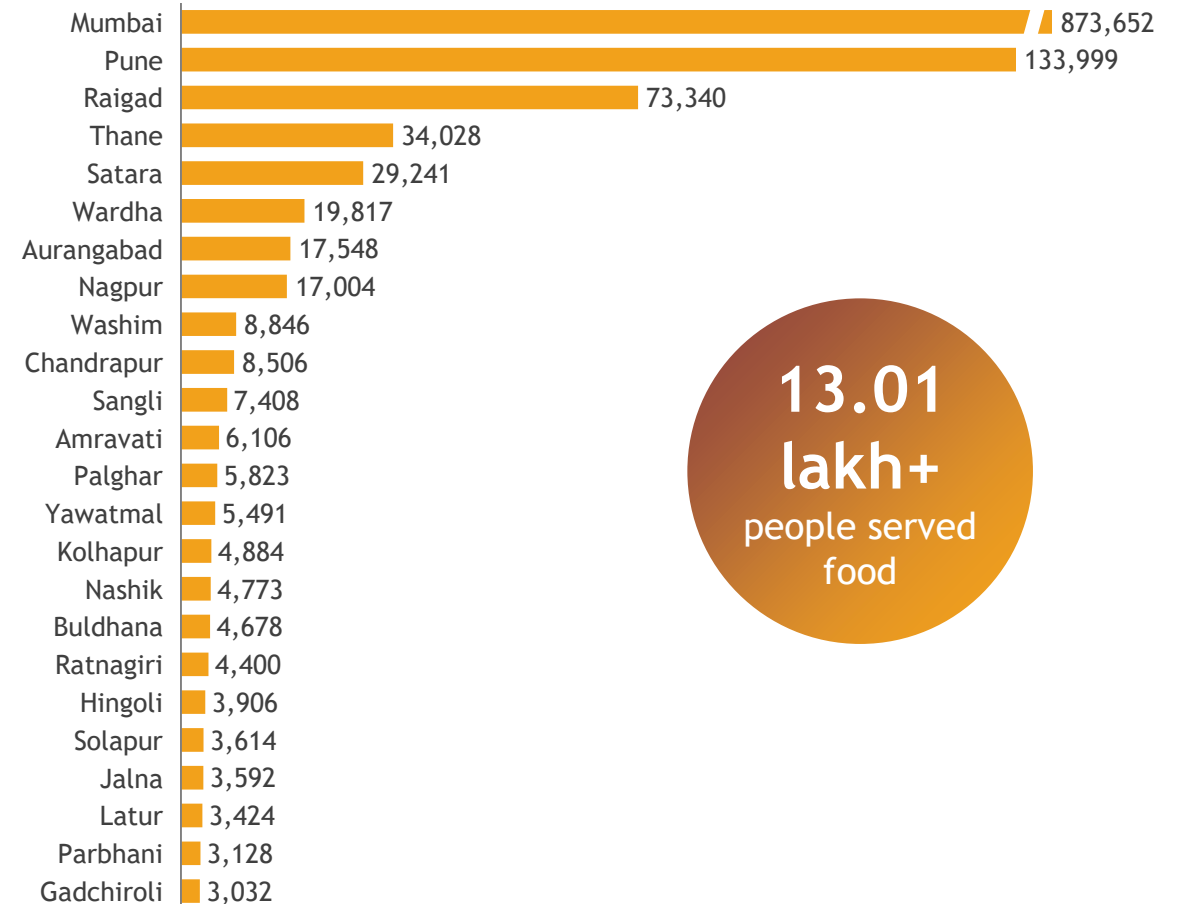
