I. Active cases in the state:

As on today, there are 37,125 active cases in the state. Details of district-wise active cases are as follows:

(Note: As the reconciliation of 288 patients shown in MCGM region and 119 in Thane district as per the ICMR portal since 7th May 2020 is in process; they have not been included in the table above.

This report is prepared based on figures provided by the authorized laboratories on Central Government's COVID-19 Portal. Because the laboratory report scrutiny and the availability of figures accordingly is an ongoing process, state cumulative numbers are subject to change.)

III. Some key observations:

 Patient doubling rate of the state was 11.5 days in the last week, which has improved today to 14.7 days.

- Out of the total laboratory tests done in the country (32,42,160), about 12.4% tests were done in Maharashtra. 3142 tests per million population in the state against the national figure of 2363 tests per million population.
- Recovery rate in the state is 31.5%
- Currently, 5,82,701 people are in home quarantine and 37,761 people are in institutional quarantine

IV. Deaths:

There were 105 COVID-related deaths reported in the state today. Out of these, 32 deaths were recorded in Mumbai, 16 in Thane, 10 in Jalgaon, 9 in Pune, 7 in Navi Mumbai, 7 in Raigad, 6 in Akola, 4 in Aurangabad, 3 in Nashik, 3 in Solapur, 2 in Satara, 1 was recorded in Ahmednagar, 1 in Nagpur, 1 in Nandurbar, 1 in Panvel, and 1 in Vasai-Virar. Additionally, 1 deaths of a Gujarat resident occurred in Mumbai.

V. Other details of deaths:

Out of the 105 deaths today, 72 were men and 33 women. 50 of them aged over 60 years, 45 were from the age group 40 to 59 years and 10 were aged less than 40 years. 66 out of 105 patients (63%) had high-risk co-morbidities such as diabetes, hypertension, heart disease, etc. Death toll in Covid-19 patients has now gone up to 1897 in the state.

Out of the total deaths reported today, 39 deaths occurred in the last two days and the rest are from the period 21st April to 24th May 2020. Out of the 66 deaths in this period, 21 were recorded in Mumbai, 15 in Thane, 10 in Jalgaon, 7 in Navi Mumbai, 7 in Raigad, 2 in Akola, 2 in Satara, 1 was recorded in Ahmednagar and 1 in Nandurbar.

VI. Lab testing details:

Out of 4,03,976 laboratory samples, 56,948 have been tested positive for COVID-19 until today.

VII. Cluster Containment Plan:

As per the guidance from Government of India, cluster containment action plan is being implemented in places where clusters of patients have been found in the state. There are 2684

active containment zones in the state currently. Total 17,119 surveillance squads worked today across the state and surveillance of 68.06 lakh population was done.
