Gap identification, preparation of action plan & gap filling	1 st July to 9 th August
Final Internal Assessment of health institutes	10 th August to 14 th August
Peer Assessment of health institutes	17 th August to 29 th August

Districts to convey the names of health institutes scoring more than 70% to the State Q A Cell (Along with scoring sheets & relevant documents/proof)	31 st August
External assessment of short listed institutes by State Award Committee	1 st September to 15 th September
Selection of the highest ranking two DHs, three highest ranking CHCs & SDH and one PHC per district (selected by the district) for state awards and those for commendation	18 th September
State to send name of the best DH to national level for the national level award ceremony	19 th September

You are instructed to constitute District Level Award Committee and External Assessment Team at Regional Level, as per the guidelines given, at the earliest, latest by 19.06.2015, and send the details to this office by 20.06.2015 on e-mail id – mdnrhm.mumbai@gmail.com and maharashtaqacell@gmail.com
